

## **“WIN YOUR BILLS & MORTGAGE PAID FOR A YEAR, UP TO \$50,000” PROMOTION**

### **HOW TO ENTER**

To be automatically entered into the draw individuals must:

- (a) have a valid GE CreditLine card or Buyer's Edge card; and
- (b) make an Eligible Purchase at Retravision (“**Partner**”) using their GE CreditLine card or Buyer's Edge card between 29/08/2010 and close of business on 31/10/2010.

Individuals must not have a delinquent account with GE Money at the time of purchase or at the time of the draw to be eligible.

An Eligible Purchase means any purchase made at Retravision during the promotional period under an “interest free promotion” or a “Buy Now Pay Later promotion” for GE CreditLine or a purchase made under an “instalment interest free promotion” or “Buy Now Pay Later promotion” for Buyer's Edge, with any “interest free promotion”, “instalment interest free promotion” or “Buy Now Pay Later” period. Purchases made under any other type of promotional offer are not eligible. An “interest free promotion” and a “Buy Now Pay Later” an “instalment interest free promotion” is a promotion where the purchaser is not required to pay any interest on their purchase for a time period specified by a representative of the Promoter at the time of purchase.

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. The Promoter is GE Finance Australasia Pty Ltd (ABN 88 000 015 485) of 572 Swan Street, Richmond, Victoria 3121, telephone 03 9921 6144.
2. Information on how to enter and the prize form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
3. Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 18 years or over who hold a valid GE CreditLine card or Buyer's Edge card. To be eligible to enter, individuals must be available to attend the prize presentation ceremony (held on a date determined by the Promoter but within 28 days of the draw). Alternatively, individuals can nominate a representative (over 18 years of age) to attend the presentation ceremony on the winner's behalf.
4. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, Retravision and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries, purchases and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
6. Multiple entries permitted, subject to the following: (a) only one entry permitted per Eligible Purchase transaction; and (b) each entry must be submitted separately and in accordance with entry requirements.
7. An Eligible Purchase made by an additional cardholder will give an automatic entry to the primary cardholder.
8. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
9. Promotion commences on 028/08/2010 and ends at close of business on 31/10/2010. The draw will take place at Anisimoff Legal, Level 4, 448 St Kilda Road, Melbourne VIC 3004 on 09/11/2010 at 10.30am AEDST.
10. The winner will be notified by mail and the winner's name will be published in The Australian on 15/11/2010.
11. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
12. The first valid entry drawn will win the prize ("**the Prize**").
13. The Prize is \$50,000, awarded in the form of a cheque to the winner.
14. The prize will be presented to the winner within 28 days of the prize draw at a presentation ceremony, at either the Retravisio store where the Eligible Purchase was made or at the GE Money Head Office, 572 Swan Street, Richmond Victoria 3121. The location of the presentation ceremony and the exact date and time of the presentation ceremony will be determined by the Promoter, in its sole discretion. The winner will be notified of the exact date, time and location of the prize presentation ceremony closer to the ceremony date. Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, the Promoter (including its officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the Promotion, including, but not limited to, where arising out of the following: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control); (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third party interference; (c) any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) if the prize presentation ceremony is cancelled for any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter; (f) any tax liability incurred by a winner or entrant; or

(g) use of the prize and attendance/participation at the prize presentation ceremony.
